Right Advocacy and Policy Concern

Civil Society Law Reform Committee

In response to the "Incident of the "Bridge of Rehabilitation" Residential Home in 2016, the Civil Society Law Reform Committee urges the relevant Government agencies to consider the following recommendations to ensure that the legal rights of vulnerable persons are protected: 1) Admission of Hearsay Evidence; 2) Reform on Cross-examination; 3) Case Management Measures; 4) Pre-trial Legal Supports; 5) Early Identification by Requiring a Social Worker in Service Unit; 6) Better Application of the "Support Person"; 7) Better Support for PMD Witnesses and Victims; 8) Training for Better Awareness and Understanding on PMDs; 9) Evaluation of Existing Practice and Services; and 10) Establishment of a Central Information System.

Special Care Dentistry for people with special needs

Since the "Loving Smiles Service" (「盈愛 • 笑容」牙科先導計劃) will be terminated in the mid of 2017, it raised the public concern on the specialist dentistry service for the people with intellectual disability. A paper was sent to government by our parents' committee of HKDSA and other parents' groups, suggesting 1) the policy on dental care education for the people with intellectual disability; 2) dentistry training for the special needs; and 3) implementation of dental service for the special needs in Hong Kong.

Health record handbook for people with Down Syndrome

Our parents' committee had contacted with around 90 parents of the Association, and found that only around 50% of them used the handbook frequently. The reason of not using the handbook were several, 60% of them revealed that they forgot to bring the handbook to the clinic, 10% realized that they needed guidance on the utilization, and some said that they were hesitated to increase doctors' workload. Overall, 90% of the parents did realize that the handbook could help record and monitor the health issues of their children, while 10% realized not, but there were 85% would choose to use the handbook again/ continuously. It was obvious that most of the parents' committee will encourage every parent through the parents' network and do more education on the utilization of the handbook in coming year.


